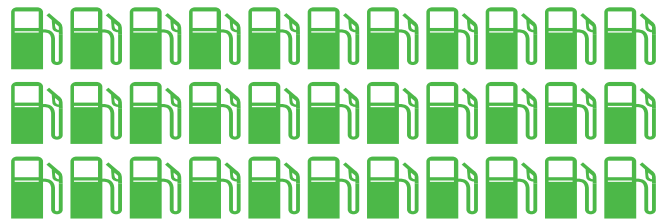
WALK PITTSBURGH – A COUPLE MILLION STEPS IN THE RIGHT DIRECTION

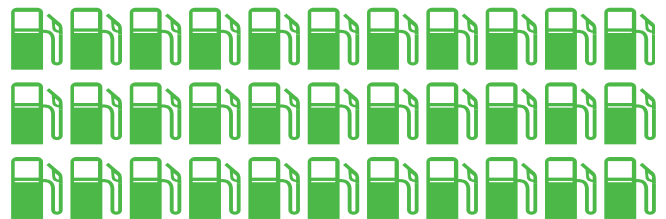
