ACTA works to improve employee retention, increase productivity, and reduce absenteeism and late arrivals for Airport Corridor businesses.

ACTA offers group presentations and individualized advice to your employees about the best way to get to work and coordinates transportation to fill in gaps in their daily commute, from ridesharing to our on-demand RideACTA shuttle service, which now serves nearly 200 Airport Corridor businesses and provides tens of thousands of rides each year.

ACTA also hosts transportation fairs to better connect employers with employees by explaining available transportation options and services in the region.





ACTA brings innovative transportation solutions to the Airport Corridor that benefits area commuters, businesses and municipalities. Our research and innovation produces new knowledge about mobility issues and offers practical solutions that drive, proactive, replicable improvements.

Major ACTA studies including *Commuting in the Corridor, Moving Around Within a Suburban Commercial Area* and *Re-Thinking the Suburban Bus Stop* documented innovative, practical, transportation ideas that led to transportation improvements in the Airport Corridor.

These improvements include: the construction of the Super Stop at IKEA which includes the suburbs first bike workstation, the re-timing of traffic signals in the Robinson/North Fayette commercial area, the addition of a signalized intersection on Park Manor Boulevard at IKEA, shared bike lanes from the Montour Trail to the Super Stop at IKEA and new pedestrian crosswalks on Park Manor Boulevard.



ACTA is the leading resource in the Airport Corridor for all of your transportation questions and needs. We're a trusted source for the most current local traffic advisories and construction information.

As an ACTA member you will receive the latest construction advisory e-mails right at your desk. You can also access timely information on specific construction projects in the region through our public outreach program.

We also use our knowledge to educate our members on mobility choices available in the Airport Corridor through innovative programs like our on-road bike map (a first in the Pittsburgh suburbs) and accompanying smart phone app as well as WalkPittsburgh.org, an initiative ACTA launched with Pittsburgh's two other TMAs.



ACTA works to sustain the economic vitality of the Airport Corridor. A respected leader in local transportation issues, ACTA receives contracted funding for operating support from local, state and federal sources, as well as donations from local townships and businesses.

We also earn grants from various sources to conduct transportation related studies and implement their recommendations.
